EXHIBIT SPACE

Artist will be assigned a numbered space that will measure **12x12 feet**. Artist must bring their own display, set-up, tables, chairs, etc. You are encouraged to demonstrate your craft.

ARTIST HOSPITALITY

Complimentary coffee and donuts will be available in the morning for artists during set up. Hospitality room open all day.

TIME

Artist must be set up and ready 1/2 hour before the start of Event. No early tear down. You must stay until 4:00pm.
